1. The following Clause shall be inserted  
in the 4th clause of the "eligibility" criteria of  
the Scheme as:

4 (2) However for traditional artisan,  
there will not be any restriction on  
qualification.

4 (3) Should be in the age group of 18-60.  
However for traditional artisan, there will  
not be any age restrictions.

2. The following Clause in the 7th clause  
of the "Commencement of Course" criteria of  
the Scheme shall be replaced.

The courses may be conducted in batches  
as per the timing suitable/convenient for the  
needy women artisans.

3. The following clause shall be replaced  
in the 9th clause of the "Identification and  
selection of trainees" criteria of the Scheme  
as:

The identification and selection of  
trainees shall be done by 3 members of  
the selection committee. The Director shall  
constitute the committee and shall also  
modify as per the requirement. The  
committee shall consist of the following  
officials:

(1) Assistant Director/Technical  
Officer, as Chairperson,

(2) Designer/Head Clerk, Member,  
and

(3) Inspector as Member Secretary.

4. The following clause shall be replaced in the 11th clause of the "Location of the training centre" criteria of the Scheme as:

The training programme shall be conducted in the premises of the concerned Village Panchayat or in the nearest available Government premises.

If both the options are not available, then the programme can be conducted in the house of any artisan and for that purpose house owner shall be given incentive of Rs. 4,000/- per month in rural area and Rs. 6,000/- per month in urban area to conduct the training programmes.

5. The following Clause in the sub-clause 1 of clause 12 of the "Trainers" criteria of the Scheme shall be replaced.

12 (1) Each training programme shall be conducted by Mentor, Weaver Master, Weaver Assistant, Master Trainer/Instructor, Assistant Trainer/Attendant.

6. The following clause in the sub-clause 3 of Clause 12 shall be replaced.

12 (3) Trainers of the trade which are not available in the Department shall be hired on contract basis.

7. The following clauses shall be inserted after sub-clause 4 of the clause 12.

5) Mentor shall be paid remuneration of Rs. 800/- per day.

6) Weaver Master shall be paid remuneration of Rs. 600/- per day.

7) Weaver Assistant shall be paid remuneration of Rs. 400/- per day.

8) Master Trainer/Instructor engaged under the scheme for imparting training in various trades will be paid with remuneration of Rs. 14,200/- per month.

9) Assistant Trainer/Attendant engaged under the scheme for imparting training in various trades will be paid with remuneration of Rs. 11,480/- per month.

10) All the trainers mentioned above shall be given actual bus fare in case they travel beyond 8 kms. from their residence.

8. The following clause shall be replaced in the 13th clause of the "Syllabus for the training Programme".

Syllabus for the training programme shall be framed by the committee constituted under clause 9.

9. The following clause shall be inserted as clause 16.

Department of Handicrafts, Textile & Coir may sponsor the candidates for the training courses/Diploma courses in various trades such as Handloom Weaving, Coir, Wood, Pottery, Bamboo, Metal Crafts, Stone Carving and similar such trades in the Institutions functioning outside Goa on the following conditions:

1. Candidates should be a resident of Goa for last 15 years.

2. Candidates shall fulfill the criteria fixed by the Institute.

3. Institute should be registered with Government of India or respective State Government.

4. The upper limit for the sponsorship shall be 3 lakhs per annum which includes course fees, note books, books, lodging & boarding expenditure and its related miscellaneous expenditure.

5. The committee constituted under clause 9 shall recommend the candidate for the sponsorship and also certify the bills towards training courses.

6. The said committee shall also draw the procedure to invite the applications from the candidates as well as recommend the registered Institute to sponsor the candidates.

10) After clause 16, the following clause shall be inserted as clause 17.

17. Director shall be the Sanctioning Authority.

11) After clause 17, the following clause 18 shall be inserted.

18. *Relaxation.*— The Government shall be empowered to relax any or all clauses

or conditions of the scheme to the genuine artisans.

12) After clause 18, the following clause 19 shall be inserted.

19. The Government shall be empowered to modify any of the clauses of the scheme if required.
